Chapter 2: Installation Instructions and Licensing

These installation instructions assume that you have either a fresh or a customized installation of any version of OpenCart 2.3.x

Warning: If your OpenCart is **not** a fresh installation, files and database backup is highly recommended.

- 1) Unzip the downloaded ZIP file into a new folder.
- 2) Enter the newly created directory and upload the contents of the "upload" directory to your server in the root directory of your site. The root directory is where the admin/ and catalog/ directories of your site are located. You can use FTP to do the upload, or any other way you feel comfortable with.
- 3) Log in to your OpenCart admin panel and go to Extensions > Extension Installer. Upload the "radiance_theme.ocmod.xml" OCMOD file located in the "ocmod" folder in the downloaded zip. Once you upload the file, don't forget to click the "Refresh" button on the top right.

Note: If you receive an error "*Could not connect as...*", this means that your OpenCart FTP settings are not properly configured, or FTP is not enabled on your server. To resolve this, follow these steps:

3.1) Go to **System > Settings > Edit > FTP** and update your FTP settings. After you are done, try uploading the files again. If it does not work and you receive the same error "*Could not connect as...*", follow the next step.

3.2) Go to this link:

<https://isenselabs.com/products/view/quickfix-extensions-installer-issue-when-ftp-support-disabled> and download and install the **Quickfix** for the OpenCart Extension Installer. After you are done, try uploading the ocmod file again.

- 4) Go to **Extensions > Extensions > Themes > Radiance Theme** and install the theme.
- 5) After Step 4, click the **Edit** button and choose Radiance in the **Theme Directory** dropdown menu. After that, Enable the theme from the Status dropdown.
- 6) Go to **System > Settings > Edit**. Select Radiance theme in the **Theme** dropdown menu.

7) Congratulations! Radiance Theme is now installed. You can access it **from Extensions > Extensions > Themes > Radiance Theme**.

Chapter 3: Configuring the Radiance Theme

Radiance Theme is a lightweight theme without extensive settings and customizations. It has a single, simple purpose – to give your store an elegant and flexible design that will easily fit your brand identity.

To make you feel more comfortable with the theme, we have a few configuration tips that will help you increase the user experience and attention of your customers.

First, go to **Extensions > Extensions > Modules** and then choose **Account**.

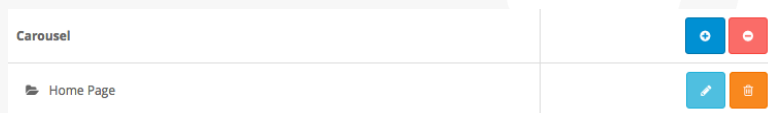


This is a core OpenCart module. Click **Edit** and enable it.

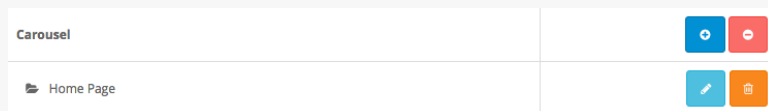
Next, from the **Extensions > Extensions**, choose **Modules** and then find the **Brand** module. Click **Install** button.




And click **Edit** and enable it as well.



Now, for the Carousel. Use the Carousel module to create a new carousel.



Click edit and enter the following settings. Keep the dimension values:


For the banner, you can use the core Banner module to create a new one and assign it in the Edit Carousel **Banner** field.






The next core module that needs to be enabled is Category. Click Edit and enable it. Don't forget to Save.







For the Theme settings, go to **System > Settings > Edit Store** and select the **Option** tab. Your **Category Product Count** should be set to **No**.





For the Slideshow on the home page, go to **Extensions > Extensions > Modules** and add a new slideshow module using the core Slideshow extension or edit the existing one.




Follow the settings below to create your slideshow. The dimensions must remain the same:
